A Tekonsha Fire Department representative suggested a seperate contract between Girard Township and TFD to cover the area mentioned. Girard Township currently has a contract with the Coldwater Fire Department to cover all of Girard Township. Recommendation from the board is to have Treasurer Julie Waterbury and Trustee Candy Cox arrange a meeting with Coldwater City Manager, Keith Baker to review and discuss possible modifications to the current contract that would satisfy the concerns.
